

## **POETRY**

Number of players: Any

Space: Any

Materials needed: Notebook paper and a pencil/ pen

## Procedure:

1. The rhythm of a drum being played is a pattern of sound. Using the syllables a drum inspires, create a pattern of repeating words.

- 2. Read silently and aloud several poems with strong meter, discuss the rhythms heard, and then identify the words or phrases that create the rhythm.
- 3. Create an interesting "Rhythm Song" (a series of rhythms over a set duration of time) by using a drum, handclaps, etc.
- 4. Using the syllables that the Rhythm Song inspires, make a poem using the exact number of syllables and phrasing.
- 5. Feel free to use made-up words and sounds to add color to the poem.

Rhythm, pattern, writing skills, creativity
