CANVAS PAINTING


Duration: 2 hours

MATERIALS NEEDED

- 1. Canvas (10x10 is what we utilized but feel free to go bigger or smaller)
- 2. Graphite Transfer Paper
- 3. Pencils
- 4. Copies of images taken from paintings by Lindy Chambers
- 5. Acrylic Paint
- 6. Paintbrushes

INTRODUCTION

- 1. Watch the <u>interview with Lindy</u> <u>Chambers</u> and spend time viewing images of her work.
 - a. Take notice of Lindy's use of color in her works. She tries to not use the same color more than once
 - b.What colors do you notice? Why do you think she chose these colors?
 - c. What colors will you use in your painting? Will you do a monochromatic scheme? Complementary colors?
 - d. What objects do you notice in her paintings?



ACTIVITY:

- 1. Select one of the provided images (see below)
- 2. Place the transfer paper on top of your canvas then place your image on top of the transfer paper. (Canvas, transfer paper, image)
- Using a pencil, trace the image.
 Add as little or as much detail as you would like!
- 4. Once done, remove your paper from your canvas. Erase any extra markings or lines.
- 5. Select what color paints you would like to utilize. Will your piece be monochromatic? Will you use complementary colors? Pastels? The choice is up to you. Just remember to not be afraid of color!
- 6. Begin painting on your canvas.
- 7. Once you are done painting, let your work dry then display it how you like!
