Habla su arte de sanación ante la masculinidad tóxica

Con el arte, la artista regia Bibi Flores desarrolló un proceso de sanación y empoderamiento feminista dirigido a mujeres sobrevivientes de abusos sexuales que se enfrentan a una sociedad patriarcal.

Radicada en Nueva York desde hace 16 años, la creadora trabaja en el proyecto "Goodbye to assholes, I deserve much better (Adiós a los cabrones, porque me merezco algo mucho mejor)", desde el 2010 a la fecha.

"Las obras enseñan el proceso de sanación de heridas energéticas que tienen que ver con trauma y abuso para enfocarse al empoderamiento y la sanación a la mujer por los sistemas en los que ha habido masculinidad tóxica", dijo la pintora en entrevista.

"Soy sobreviviente de muchas cosas, incluyendo violación, violencia doméstica de relaciones de pareja, que viene del machismo en México. Ha habido un tabú para hablar de estas cosas por mucho".

Hija del pintor Jaime Flores, la artista que comenzó su carrera en 1997 se enfoca en la abstracción, influida por su padre, pero con un lenguaje y propuesta propios, además de sustentarlo en una investigación que pronto publicará.

"Todas las pinturas e instalaciones vienen para empoderar y sanar, y documentan este proceso y etapas de mi investigación. (Las pinturas) muestran cómo la energía se ve y va pasando", explicó. "Es un mensaje, y apoya a los sobrevivientes porque se conecta con todas y todos".

Incluso, dijo, el título del proyecto tiene un significado.

"Va por etapas, la primera se enfoca en decirles adiós, luego cuando te empiezas a reconocer a ti mismo y después cuando te sientes merecedor. Es algo profundo y toma a veces un poco de tiempo".

Algunas de las obras de este proyecto están en la exposición colectiva "Dissolving Borders", que estará hasta el domingo en JVS Project Space, en Manhattan. En la muestra participan 25 artistas del New Latinx Art Collective, al que pertenece Flores.

El grupo está integrado por más de 70 artistas de diferentes disciplinas de todo el mundo, entre ellos seis mexicanos.
