Duration: 30 min

Materials Needed:

- Air dry clay
- Clay tools
- Thick paper
- Sharpened pencil
- Black Paint
- Styrofoam



Introduction:

- Visit https://womenandtheirwork.org/upcoming/alejandra-almuelle/ and review Alejandra's work
 - Discuss the impressions of the exhibition
 - What did the work mean to you?
 - How did the work make you feel?
 - What piece spoke to you the most and why?

Activity

- 1. Everyone will first get a piece of paper
- 2. Cut the paper into a circle
- 3. Paint the circle black
 - a. While the paint dries, move on to the next activity
- 4. Everyone will grab a piece of air dry clay
- 5. Squeeze the clay in your fist and it will create the forms in Alejandra's work



- 6. After completing the hand clay, you can go back to your circle paper!
- 7. The next step is to place the circle onto the styrofoam
- 8. Grab a pencil and begin poking holes through your circle piece like Alejandra's!
