DON'T CRY FOR ME WHEN I'M GONE

Duration 60 min

Objectives:

Students will create their own collage. A collage is a piece of art made by putting various different materials together.

Materials:

- Invite students to bring their own personal items that remind them of a memory or moment they cherish.
- Gather nicknacks all different varieties and sizes for students to collage with i.e. toys, jewelry clothes beads, feathers ect.
- Paper in variety of color
- Pencils
- Markers
- Sticker letters
- Variety of fabric
- Cotton balls
- Scissors
- Clear tape
- Computer x1 and a screen to project the computer display on

**** No glue needed**, the goal is to be able to repurpose the material for multiple classes. If that does not apply, **hot glue** would work great because of heavier materials.

Room Setup:

Tables and/or individual desks for the students to work at.

A materials table (a table where all the materials students can use are on display).

Intro:

Q. What smells remind you of your childhood? Or What is something that makes you think of a person or thing you love?

Show prepared examples or collage art.

Activity:

- We are going to make collages that reflect a memory or moment we cherish.
- Invite students to takeout the item(s) they brought. For those who did not bring anything allow them to go and pick from the items provided, 1-2 items.
- One all students have their main items which they will create around.
- Allow students freely collect craft supplies to use in their collage.
- Students should spend bulk of the time making a collage.
- Use the last 5 minutes to allow students to walk around and observe each others work, those who desire to share/show.
